You are about to purchase a product that is not simple and may be difficult to understand.

What is this product?

TYPE

You invest into a debt obligation of the category Investment Product (Credit Linked Note).

TERM

This product has a fixed term until 10/20/2024.

OBJECTIVES

The aim of this product is to obtain a higher yield by assuming the default risk of the reference entities. As a result, you assume the credit risk of both the issuer and the reference entities. The product has a rising interest rate and a fixed maturity, unless a credit event occurs. The interest payments and the redemption amount will depend on the solvency of several reference entities. As long as the solvency of the reference entities is not impaired and no credit event occurs, interest will be paid regularly and the product will be redeemed at the redemption rate at maturity. However, if at least one reference entity is subject to a credit event, the redemption amount as well as the outstanding interest payments will be reduced. Additional credit events related to the other reference entities will lead to further reductions. The redemption amount can be significantly lower than the principal amount. If all reference entities are subject to a credit event, the interest payments and the redemption will be omitted completely and a total loss will occur. 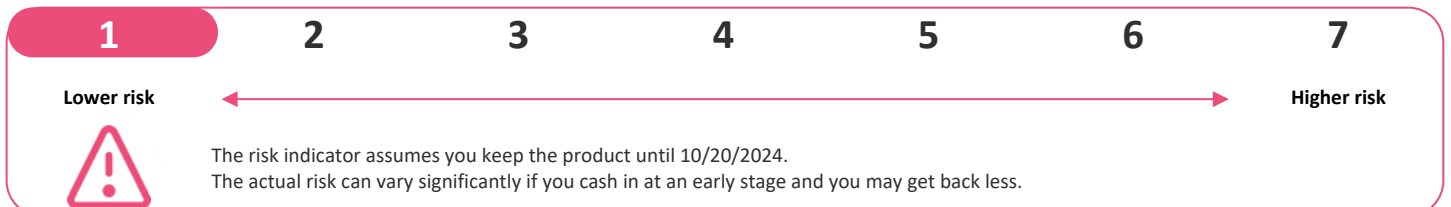

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

RISK INDICATOR

We have classified this product as 1 out of 7, which is the lowest risk class.
